Issue:

The links to the allowed-with list for NDcPP as provided in Section 2 of NDcPPv2.1 and NDcPPv2.2e are pointing to the allowed-with list for NDcPPv2.0e and are therefore outdated. The links should point to the latest allowed with lists for NDcPP.

Resolution:

The links to the allowed-with list for NDcPP are outdated and need to be updated. Therefore, the last paragraph in Section 2 of NDcPPv2.1 and NDcPPv2.2e shall be modified as follows:
